

FUND ALLOCATION FROM THE ANNUAL CHARITY BENEFIT DINNER

The Benefit Dinner that was held on March 21, 2026, generated \$301,258 pesos.

The Festival of Trees that was held in December of 2025 generated \$55,667 pesos. This totals \$356,925 pesos.

The Charitable Giving Committee has decided to allocate the monies to the organizations or programs in the Kino Bay community that are listed below. These funds are designated to be used for assistance with program functions, equipment needs, and/or facility improvements.

Club Deportivo receives 30% of the Benefit Dinner funds which is \$90,378 pesos. This goes into The Capital Fund.

This leaves \$210,880 pesos available for allocation from the Benefit dinner. All the money generated from The Festival of the Trees goes into this Charity Fund as well. The total from both events is \$266,547 pesos. We are in the process of distributing this money, as well as most of the funds that were available from prior years. We reserve \$50,000 pesos in case of emergency.

The Edward T. Robinson Jr. Family Foundation funded the bathroom repairs at the Lazaro Cardenas schools. We are in the process of identifying projects/needs for the remainder of this money.
