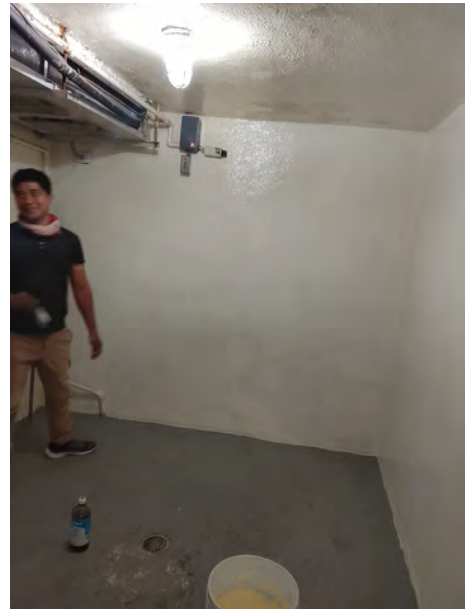
And of course summer is time for maintenance!
